

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY MOUNT ISA CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS

For the safety, comfort and security of all persons in Mount Isa City Council Chambers the following conditions apply to everybody entering:

- All Visitors are to sign the Visitor Register and wear a Visitor pass at all times.
- The following items are prohibited:
  - Banners and posters; and
  - o Cameras (other than that of authorised media personnel); and
  - Electronic audio/visual recording devices (other than that of authorised media personnel).
- Visitors must not interrupt the conduct of business and are to remain quiet at all times.
- Visitors are permitted silent use of their mobile phones for texting and emailing.
   They are *not* permitted to use phones for recording, talking, or any usage that generates noise.
- Pursuant to section 11.2.1 of Council's Standing Orders Policy a member of the public may take part in the proceeding of a meeting only when invited to do so by the chairperson.
- Any person/s in the Council Chambers must leave the meeting when requested to do so by the chairperson.

Council reserves the right to refuse entry to the Council Chambers if the above conditions are not complied with.
